1. The course fees and deposit are valid only for the person, course and dates specified on the enrolment form.
2. Full payment for the course must be received strictly 3 weeks prior to course commencement. When this payment has been received Sol Camps International will send a confirmation of booking as well as an information pack relating to the course, this pack contains vital information concerning the course.
3. Cancellation: If written notification is received at least 30 days prior to course commencement then 50% of the total fee will be charged. Anytime within 30 days of course commencement will incur a 100% charge of the total course.
4. Postponement of course within 30 days of course commencement will incur the additional week's course fees.
5. Students who arrive after the start of their course, who are absent during the course or leave before the end of the course will not be given a refund, unless exceptional circumstances apply which are agreed to with Sol Camps International.
6. Flight Details must be received a minimum of 2 weeks prior to flight arrival. Any changes made within 2 weeks will incur an additional £15 fee per change.
7. Transfer fees will not be refunded if you fail to inform of any changes in your itinerary or if you miss your connections.
8. Sol Camps International accepts students on the assumption that they are of sound health. It is mandatory for all students to have medical and travel insurance to cover the duration of their course whilst in the UK. Students are responsible for any medical expenses incurred.
9. The minimum age for students attending the Junior Summer Course is 11 years old.
10. Students whose behaviour prejudices the best interests of the course will be asked to leave before the end of their course and no refund on the course fees will be payable by Sol Camps International.
11. When necessary, Sol Camps International reserves the right to alter the timetable and/or transfer students from one class or course to another, from one time of study to another, and to merge small classes or cancel classes and courses. Fees may also be subject to change.
